Under the federal Every Student Succeeds Act, states are required to designate schools for support and improvement based on both schoolwide (Comprehensive Support and Improvement) and student group (Additional Targeted Support and Improvement) performance on a range of academic and student success measures.

The Minersville Area Elementary Center is one of roughly 200 schools statewide designated for Additional Targeted Support and Improvement. This designation is based on data suggesting the need to prioritize additional supports for our Special Education Students in the following areas: academic proficiency on state assessments and academic growth. This designation will provide opportunities for our school to partner with stakeholders to identify our school community's most pressing needs, select strategies to support those needs, and work together to implement the select strategies.
