Subject: Revised Guidelines for 2014 *White and Blue Spirit Days*
Date: September 2, 2014

The following is a revision of the information that was sent home with your child earlier. In order to promote school spirit, *White and Blue Spirit Days* have been extended to include all Fridays during the school year, beginning on Friday, September 5, 2014 and ending May 29, 2015. In order to promote school spirit, the students will be able to demonstrate their school spirit and support for the high school and youth sports teams by wearing their school colors and school sports shirts. These are the following dress guidelines for *White and Blue Spirit Days*:

- (1) Students may wear a blue colored (any shade) t-shirt or crew cut sweat shirt (no hooded sweatshirts are permitted).
- (2) Students may wear a white colored t-shirt or crew cut sweat shirt (no hooded sweatshirts are permitted).
- (3) Students may wear a blue and white colored t-shirt or sweat shirt (no hooded sweatshirts are permitted).
- (4) Students may wear any colored "Battlin Miner/Minersville" t-shirts or crew cut sweatshirts (no hooded sweatshirts are permitted).
- (5) Youth football players may wear their football team jerseys.
- (6) Cheerleaders may wear their cheerleading uniforms/outfits.
- (7) Youth soccer, basketball, baseball, etc. league shirts and/or jerseys, even if they are not white and/or blue are permitted to be worn.
- (8) Only approved dress code uniform pants can be worn.
- (9) No shirts, no matter what color, should be worn with rock groups, professional sports teams, or any other insignias that do not promote "school spirit" as outlined above.

Participation in this activity is voluntary. Students may choose to wear their normal, approved dress code clothing on these days if they wish.
