

## **Keystone Exam Preparation**

### **Keystone Exams**

The Keystone Exams are end of course assessments designed to evaluate proficiency in academic content. ***Beginning with the class of 2017, students must demonstrate proficiency on the Algebra I, Literature, and Biology Keystone Exams to graduate.*** Students will be offered multiple opportunities to take the keystones throughout their high school careers.

### **Keystone Exam Participation**

Because the 11th Grade PSSA has been eliminated, in 2012-2013 all 11th grade students must take the Algebra I, Literature and Biology Keystone Exams. Additionally, any 8th, 9th, or 10th grade student who has previously completed a related Keystone course, or is presently enrolled in a Keystone related course should participate in the associated exam.

### **Keystone Exam Design**

Each Keystone Exam is composed of two modules (test sessions). Each module is designed to take 1 - 1.5 hours to complete. The exams will consist of multiple-choice questions and constructed-response, or open-ended questions.
